

## THE CULT As an outsider looking at Ahmadiyya, I never understood

why many former Ahmadis so vehemently call Ahmadiyya a cult. Is Ahmadiyya a religion or is it a cult? When does a religion become a cult? Psychologist Philip G. Zimbardo identified four primary factors that distinguish a cult from a regular religion, upon which Mitch Horowitz appended two:

Behaviour control, such as monitoring of where you go and what you do.

Information control, such as discouraging members

- from reading criticism of the group.
- Thought control, placing sharp limits on doctrinal questioning;
- Emotional control, using humiliation or guilt.
- **Financial** control, either through mandatory payments or full disclosure of financial information.
  - Extreme leadership, such as excessively revering the leader.
